SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS

At F.C. Joyce, we work extremely hard to meet the needs of all students. The whole staff considers every student as "our" student. Grade level teams collaborate and share strategies on a weekly basis and engage in regular professional development. We hold a number of family involvement events each year, including our monthly family Friday read-ins and coffee and conversation with the principal, GLAD arts nights, and Fall Festival.

FC Joyce offers extra-curricular activities and enrichment including benchmark field trip experiences for grades 3 - 6, science camp for 6th graders, and a host of sports for grades 5 - 8, including volleyball, soccer, basketball and wrestling. We encourage academics and good attendance with monthly Attend-A-Dance for perfect attendance and the 95% Club for students with only one absence, as well as awards for academics and character. We have a Zeroes Aren't Permitted (ZAP) program for grades 7 - 8 that supports students and makes it not an option to take a zero on any assignment.

NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

We offer music or art in all grades 1 - 6, along with other arts opportunities. Through a CTA grant, we are holding three family Arts Nights throughout the school year. We are one of the few schools in the area to offer wrestling, as well as participation in the K - 8 and middle school sports leagues. Our 7/8th grade boys won the league championship for basketball in 2017.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

We offer the MASTERS program after school, along with Skills, Opportunities, and Recognition Academy (SOAR) for students in grades 3 - 6. Several teachers also tutor after school to help students who may be struggling.
